DELMARVALOUS QUILTERS BONUS SKILL BUILDER

TRIPLE TRIANGLE BLOCK Dee Christopher



Starting note: Measurements are based on a plain square (lower left). That square can be ANY configuration. This month's block is a half-square triangle unit. Establish your square. The numbers will work!

Starting with the bottom square, determine your finished size and add $\frac{1}{2}$ " to cut. **Cut 2 squares.**

Cut 2 rectangles width of square plus 1".

Join as in diagram.

Sew square to rectangle, 2 times. Then sew together.

Mark before cutting.

From the back of the block, mark a 45-degree line from the corner, lining up with the square-rectangle intersection.

Be sure to keep your points. You may want to mark just a thread away from the intersection.

Measure length and width of unit before cutting.

Cut a rectangle of that size. Layer together and sew on both lines.

Measure $\frac{1}{2}$ " from sewing line and cut. Do both sides.

2 Triple Triangle Units are formed.

Starting square can be any configuration.
