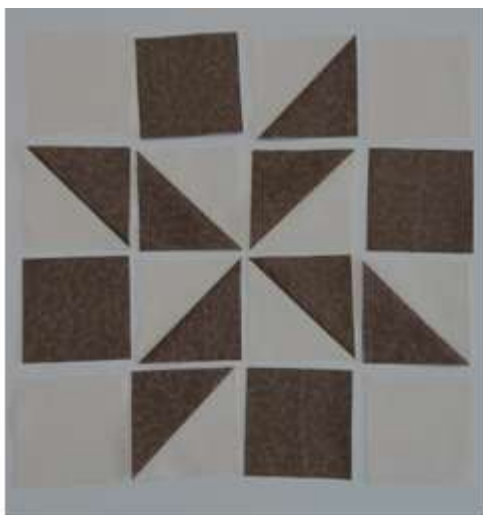
Christmas Party Group A

BLOCK OF THE MONTH



An opportunity to learn a new skill or refresh an existing one!

Each month a new block based on HSTs (half square triangles) method will be featured in the newsletter May through September. Directions for making HSTs eight at a time and each block layout will be included monthly. Participation is optional and you know we will love to see your results at monthly show and tell. You will need 3 fabrics, a light as background, and a dark for high contrast and a medium (as an accent in the last couple of blocks). Choose solids or small prints or tone on tone fabrics. To make all five blocks in the same fabric combinations you will need 1 yard of light, 3/4 yard of dark, and 1/2 yard of medium. If you want to mix up colors just keep the background light fabric the same in all blocks. October will be a final product of your work. Each month the instructions for all prior blocks will be attached to the newsletter. Hope this peeks your interest and your skills. This month is Block #2 Shooting Star.

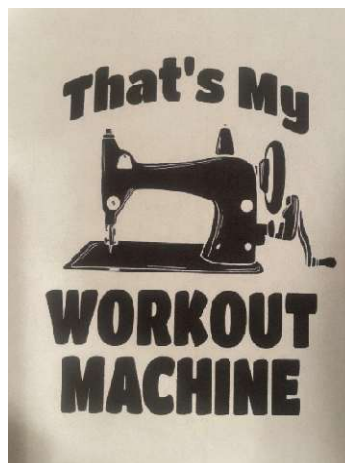
